PDRRM-CSU lead earthquake drill with other agencies



OFF THEY GO. Faculty, non-teach and students of the Catanduanes State University went on an earthquake drill done simultaneously nationwide with PDRRMO and DILG as lead evaluators. This is this year's ceremonial agency of the province during the drill. (cprmc)

THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER Risk Reduction Management (PDRRM) led by Mr. Jerry Beo, and the Catanduanes State University (CSU) headed by Dr. Minerva I. Morales, jointly conducted the earthquake drill at the CSU grounds on September 28, 2016. The PDRRM conducted an orientation at the CSU gymnasium a day before the drill which was participated by all faculty members, employees and students.

The CSU is this year's ceremonial agency of the province in the conduct of the simultaneous earthquake drill which started 9:00 o'clock in the morning. Other participating agencies include the DPWH, PNP, LGU, SSS, PSA, DAR and GSIS, among others. The DILG provincial office represented by LGOO VI William T. Aldea, led the team of evaluators during the drill.

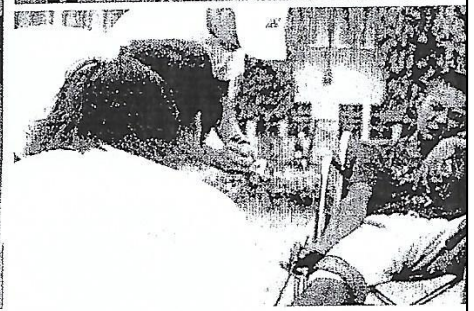
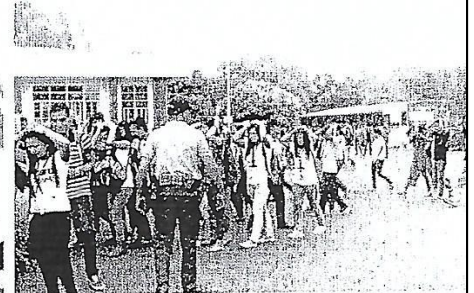
The CSU through its NSTP Director, Dr. Gemma M. Samas, provided coordination with other participating units and other stakeholders such as the BFP, the Red Cross and Health personnel during the event. In an interview, PDRRM Officer Jerry Beo said that earlier, his office had received a directive from his



regional counterpart, Bernardo R. Alejandro IV advising him to spearhead the 3rd quarter nationwide simultaneous earthquake drill. He said that the CSU remains a strong partner of his office in said event. It was learned that "after-activity" reports were required of respective agencies as to how they were able to carry on to the drill.

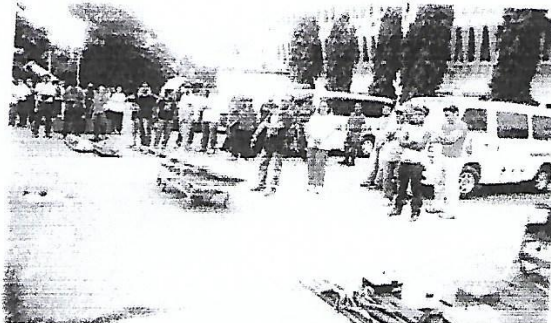
The PDRRM advised that aside from the PHIVOLCS template which focuses on the basic "duck, cover, and hold" concept, those in the drill were encouraged to include the testing, validating and evaluating their respective local contingency plans. These would in turn, assess the agency's capability to respond to an emergency like

earthquake. With the NSTP as coordinator, this year's support teams included from building safety inspection, evacuation, communication, first aid safety. There were about participating faculty, staff and employees from CSU this year's earthquake drill.

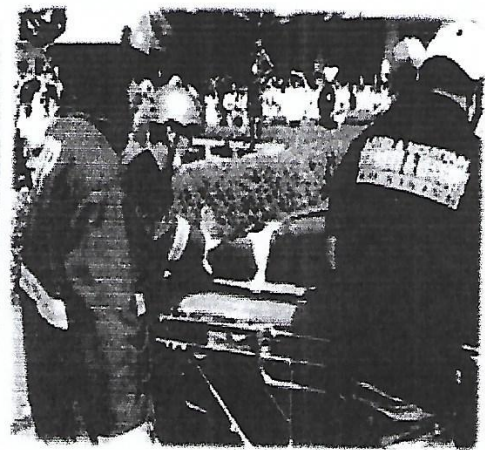




The application of first aid performed by trained officers

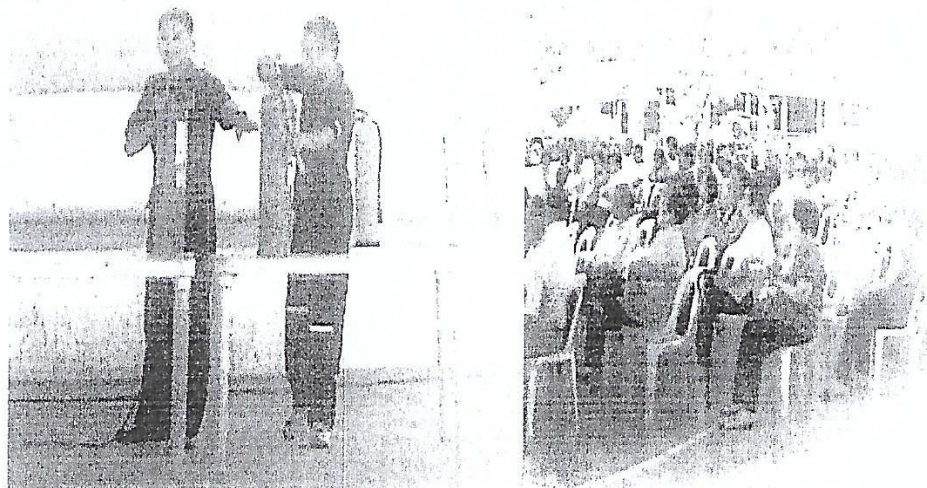

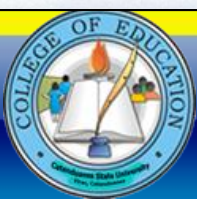
