## CatSU signs MoU for Institutional Cooperation with SEARCA

The Catanduanes State University (CatSU) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture (SEARCA) on January 11, 2023.

A virtual signing ceremony via Zoom was held to signify the start of the partnership between the two institutions. CatSU President Dr. Patrick Alain T. Azanza and SEARCA Director Dr. Glenn B. Gregorio inked the said agreement and this was witnessed by the key officials from both institutions.

"We need to stay visible and relevant during these times," said Dr. Gregorio. The SEARCA Director also emphasized in his opening message the importance of partnership with key institutions to carry out their goals. Likewise, Dr. Azanza of CatSU assured that the MoU is just the beginning of the impactful and relevant programs that will be put into action in the coming days.

## CatSU honors ‘Sir Impling’ - the Man behind the Happy Island’s Best “Latik, and Tilmok”

Mr. Simplicio G. Mendoza with the Lingap sa Diwa ng CatSU Award in a simple yet memorable ceremony, witnessed by the University’s key officials at CatSU Conference Room on January 13, 2023.

Mr. Mendoza, who is fondly called “Impling”, is a retired professor and extension worker at the University. His award was given for his selfless contribution to creatives and industry.

Sir Impling provided visual design for important cultural events in the community. As an extension worker and entrepreneur, he raised the standards of decorative arts and virtual artistry. He developed local products in the handicrafts and the food industry thereby providing livelihood opportunities to others.

Most importantly, his research skills and passion to do great allowed him to develop, standardize, and perfected the island’s famous “latik, and tilmok” – a signature mark in the province’s culture and identity.

“The signature ‘Impling’ (Tatak Impling) is indeed being felt and I believe that it is but fitting recognition to honor your contributions, and at the same time appreciate your talents and skills which hopefully could be passed on to the next generations,” Dr. Azanza said.

The president was also nostalgic as he vividly recalled the days when he was still a student of Prof. Mendoza, and gladly

shared fond memories of how to create various products out of rattan.

“Your unique way of imposing discipline by ensuring that our finished products are perfect truly translated into excellence,” Dr. Azanza recalled.

“The kind of passion that you have makes you unique that even as you leave the school, as you moved on to higher learning, you bring it all along with you and the wisdom reverberates, reminding us of the lessons that eventually prove very valuable in our career. Even as I perform my role as SUC President, I still live with the lessons I learned from you about creativity and excellence and not just be contented with mediocrity,” the president added.

Dr. Azanza also emphasized in his message that the value of meritocracy, which he is adopting in the University, happens partly because of the lessons he learned from Prof. Mendoza – that is to see the importance of quality and excellence in outputs, and that premium should be given to those who go beyond and excel.

“The university came up with this award and we hope that you would know how much you are appreciated by CatSU, the community, and the entire island because Impling Mendoza is Impling Mendoza. You are one of a kind. You belong to a generation of trailblazers and CatSU needs you to be able to pass on

to the next generation of CatSU students and employees this God-given talent and expertise that should not perish not just in the university but in the island as a whole,” Dr. Azanza said.

The key officials present namely Dr. Ramon Felipe Sarmiento, Vice President for Research, Extension, and Production Affairs, Dr. Maria Edna R. Inigo, Vice President for Administrative and Financial Affairs, Atty. Gregorio M. Sarmiento, Jr., Chief Administrative Officer, Prof. Zyra Mae T. Tumala, CIRCPDS Director, Dr. Adem Nalu V. Rubio, Extension Services Director, and the Corporate Communications Services Staff shared flashback recollections of the good old days, which also made Prof. Mendoza emotional with tears of joy when it was his time for the acceptance speech.

“Dai ko pigaexpect na tatawan ako ng ganitong award. Basta sa kapinongan, ang asa isip ko ay maging maogma sana ako sa gabos na yagibo ko lalo na pag nakakatabang ako sa ibang tawo. # Top Scientists of the Catanduanes State University as declared by the Alper-Doger (AD) Scientific Index on its latest release of World Scientist and University Rankings 2023

Top Scientists of the Catanduanes State University as declared by the Alper-Doger (AD) Scientific Index on its latest release of World Scientist and University Rankings 2023 dated October 24, 2022.

The AD Scientific Index (Alper-Doger Scientific Index), unlike other systems that provide evaluations of journals and universities, is a ranking and analysis system based on the scientific performance and the added value of the scientific productivity of individual scientists. Furthermore, it provides rankings of institutions based on the scientific characteristics of affiliated scientists.

AD Scientific Index performs rankings using a single parameter, which is the number of "Valued and Productive Scientists" staffed by a specific university. Selected after years of observation, this parameter is calculated using the total H-index and i10-index values together with the number of citations, and the last 5 years' total H-index and i10-index values along with the number of citations received over the last 5 years. We rank more than 19 500 universities using this method. A careful examination will reveal that most of the other

parameters are representations of natural academic products of "Valued and Productive Scientists." Institutions that employ a high number of "Valued and Productive Scientists," for example, scientists in the first Top 2%, Top 10%, Top 20%, Top 40%, Top 60%, Top 80% and later ranks, respectively, will naturally produce increased numbers of academic outputs listed as the parameters above.

The world rankings, regional rankings, and university rankings of scientists in this table are developed based on the total i10 index. Thus, scientists and universities can obtain their academic rankings and monitor developments in the ranking over time. For global university rankings, ranking organizations use the following parameters including the quality of education, employment rates of graduates, the quality of faculties within an individual university, international collaborations, the number of graduates and staff awarded with Nobel Prizes and Fields Medals, the number of highly cited researchers selected by Clarivate Analytics, the total number of research papers, the number of articles published by Nature and Science journals, the number of articles indexed in Science Citation Index-Expanded (SCIE) and Social Science Citation Index (SSCI), and the number of research articles receiving a high number of citations. Each ranking organization develops a ranking methodology, which attributes different % weights to selected items out of such parameters. Experienced ranking organizations evaluate 2000 - 3000 universities for ranking.

Moreover, CatSU ranks 135th out of 263 universities in the country. Truly, it's a long way to go but CatSU is steadfast in bringing honor to our island province.
